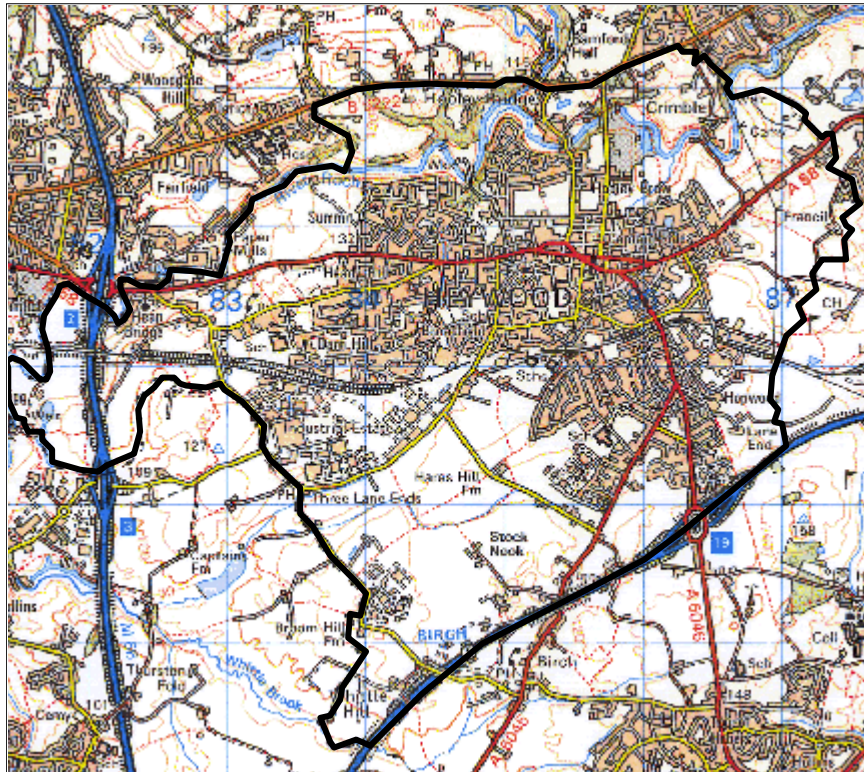

Heywood Township Profile- 10th July 2004



There are 28,505 people in the Heywood Township and 11,946 households. Children (aged 0-15) in Heywood make up 22.6% of the total population (6,450). Elderly people (aged over 75) form 6.6% of the total population (1,873). In Heywood 97.3 % of the population is White. One person households account for 31.1% of the households in Heywood (3,710). This is followed by couples with children who make up 29.37% of the households (3,504). The majority of people aged 16-74 in Heywood are in employment (60.3%). Of these, 28.3% of people are employed in the Distribution, Hotels and Catering industry (3,546). This is followed by 20.4% of people being employed in the Public Administration, Education and Health industry (2,550). In Heywood 18.1% of people classify their occupation as Elementary (2,265). This is followed by 13.3% of people who classify their occupation as Administrative and Secretarial (1,662). The majority of households in Heywood own their own home (65.4%). 16.0% of households rent their home from the council and 10.7% of households rent their home from a Housing Association or Registered Social Landlord.
