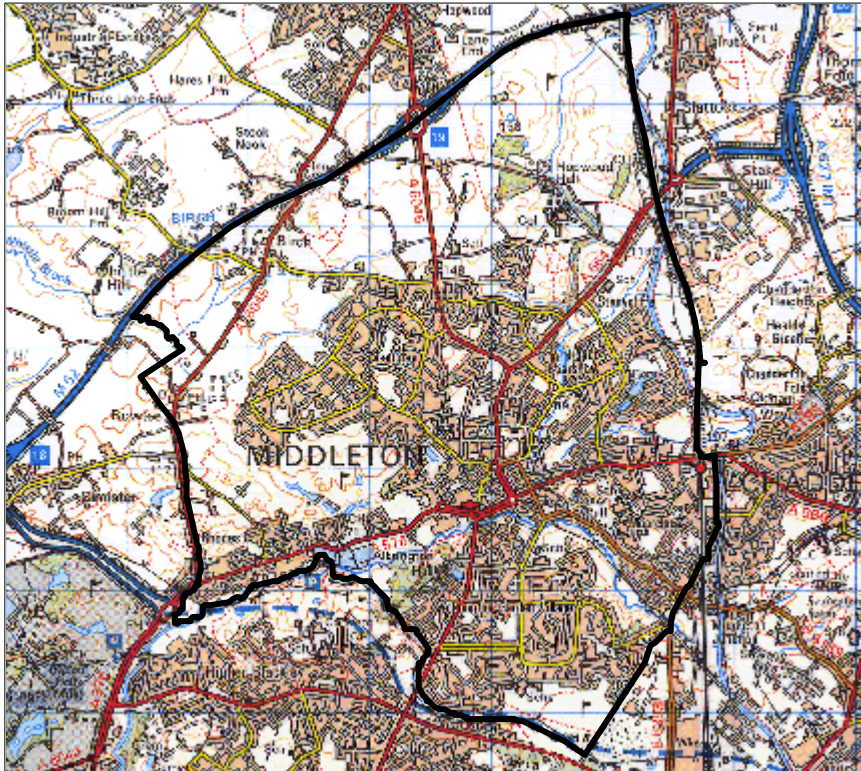

Middleton Township Profile - 10th June 2004



There are 45,580 people in the Middleton Township and 19,423 households. Children (aged 0-15) in Middleton make up 21.8% of the total population (9,938). Elderly people (aged over 75) form 7.1% of the total population (3,241). In Middleton 97.1 % of the population is White. One person households account for 32.0% of the households in Middleton (6,225). This is followed by couples with children who make up 27.3% of the households (5,302). The majority of people aged 16-74 in Middleton are in employment (57.5%). Of these, 24.7% of people are employed in the Distribution, Hotels and Catering industry (4,745). This is followed by 18.4% of people being employed in the Manufacturing industry (3,531). In Middleton 16.1% of people classify their occupation as Elementary (3,088). This is followed by 13.9% of people who classify their occupation as Administrative and Secretarial (2,661). In Middleton the majority of households own their own home (64.4%) and 24.9% of households rent their home from the council.
